### Aircraft Fleet

Air Mandalay's maintenance facility and maintenance standards are European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) Part 145 approved. Air Mandalay is the only airline in Myanmar with this approval. Air Mandalay's modern fleet is currently comprised of two ATR 72-212s and one ATR 42-320, built by Aerospatiale of France and Alenia of Italy and powered by Canadian built Pratt & Whitney engines.

### Crew

selection and training of cabin crew is aimed at providing high levels of service consistent with Myanmar's gentle traditions. Employ both local and foreign pilots who are trained at Avions de Transport Regional's (ATR) training facilities. The Aircraft Maintenance Engineers are trained at both ATR and Pratt & Whitney's facilities. Air Mandalay's aircraft are maintained to European JAR 145 standards. All aircraft in Air Mandalay's fleet are inspected twice a year by French DGAC.
